PreOrthodontic Treatment Visit- D8660 if monitoring the patient before treatment starts.

Normal use of contract visit – D8670

Orthodontic Treatment (alternative billing to a contract fee) -D8690 If you are seeing a transfer patient who has completed paying another dentist and you are going to finish.

You use this code to charge what you will charge out.

Repair of Palatal Expander – D8691

Replace lost or broken retainer – D8692

Limited Orthodontics

(Limited objective not involving the entire dentition. It may be directed at the only existing problem, or at only one aspect of a larger problem in which a decision is made to defer or forego more comprehensive therapy. Ex: Treatment in one arch only to correct crowding, partial treatment to open spaces or upright a tooth for bridge or implant and partial treatment for closure of a space.)

D8010 - limited orthodontic treatment of the primary dentition.

D8020 – limited orthodontic treatment of the transitional dentition.

D8030 – limited orthodontic treatment of the adolescent dentition.

D8040 – limited orthodontic treatment of the adult dentition.

Interceptive Orthodontic Treatment

(Treatments to lessen the severity or future effects of a malformation and to eliminate its cause. An extension of preventive orthodontics that may include localized tooth movement. Such treatment may occur in the primary or transitional dentition and may include such procedures as the redirection of ectopically erupting teeth, correction of isolated dental crossbite or recovery of recent minor space loss where overall space is adequate. The key to successful interception is intervention in the incipient stages of a developing problem to lessen the severity of the malformation and eliminate its causes. Complicating factors such as skeletal disharmonies, overall space deficiencies, or other conditions may require future comprehensive therapy. Early phases of comprehensive therapy may utilize some procedures that might also be used interceptively, but such procedures are not considered interceptive in those applications.
